Length, layout criteria and typeface options

Abstract length: 300 words • Body text: Times New Roman, 12, Lines spacing “exactly” at 16

Heading example

Title: CAPITAL LETTERS – e.g., CHARACTER, TEMPERAMENT AND PERSONALITY

Authors: Full Name – e.g., John Doe (1), Jane Doe (2), Jane Smith (1)

Affiliation: e.g., (1) Center for Family and Community Medicine, Columbia University, New York, NY, USA, (2) Child and Family Center The Rockefeller University, New York, NY.

Abstract text, even if not subdivided into paragraphs, will be organized in order to show the traditional structure of a scientific contribute:

• Introduction: theoretical and empirical background, aims of the study or of the clinical contribution • Methods: description of context and intervention • Results: summary of the main results • Discussion: treatment implications
