According to a citywide research by the Chinese University of Hong Kong (CUHK), about 25% of children and teenagers in Hong Kong experienced a mental illness in 2022 and 50% of them had two or more co-occurring illnesses. Furthermore, 8% of pupils in secondary schools reported having considered suicide at some time. This presentation will provide a family perspective on these findings and discuss how family relationships affect the mental health of children and teenagers.
